Health Alert: Instant-Soup Burns Sends Thousands of Kids to ER Yearly.

Instant soups can provide a quick meal for kids, but these food products can also lead to scalding burns. Researchers analyzed data from 2006 to 2016 and found that burns associated with instant soups and noodles affect more than 9,500 children each year with about 40% of these burns occurring on the torso. The investigators note these burns are most likely due to kids spilling hot soup or water on themselves when picking up a hot container.

This is the time to remind all of you who wish to participate in the parades for 2019 to get your insurance declaration coverages into the office. This is a necessity, not only to protect you but to protect the Shrine, and this is a requirement by-law of Imperial.

Remember we need the full page of declaration, not the card you keep in the glove box, which states your name, coverage, coverage limits, and dates of your coverage. Also, if your insurance expires in July you will need to provide a second declaration page for the remainder of the year.

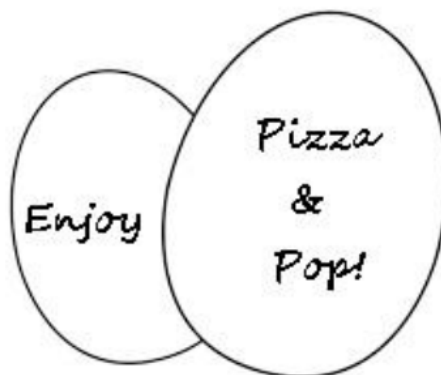
ALL APPOINTMENTS BY A POTENTATE EXPIRE AT THE END OF HIS TERM

For the information of all Nobles, when a Potentate's term expires, all appointments made by him during his administration terminate. Imperial Shrine Law states each new Potentate is the Chief Executive of a Temple and must make his own appointments, including the members of the Appointed Divan.

Each Potentate has the power and authority to replace every appointee, or he may retain any appointee if he believes it is in the best interest of the Temple. Any Noble wearing a Fez carrying a title bestowed upon him by a previous Potentate is in violation of the Imperial Code.

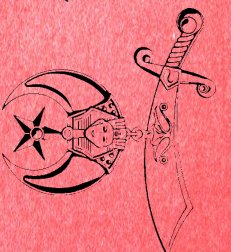
