The View From the Recorder's Office



So what else is next for us in 2020? Today I was hoping to be writing here that our first Stated Meeting since March was well attended and the Nobles were glad to be able to be getting back together. Instead, as I write this the day

after that planned August Stated, I am disappointed to say that it was the weather, rather than a virus, that conspired against us this month. On Monday, August 10th, at just after noon, Hiawatha was hit with hurricane force winds (~112 mph) and rains that downed trees, tore off roofs, and snapped power poles (3 downed power poles just up the street from us). Unfortunately, several of our Nobles in the local area lost their houses in this storm. Luckily, El Kahir did not sustain any damage (except that one of the windows in the Shrine van was broken out). We did, however, lose power. Tuesday afternoon, with Alliant Power saving that it would be several days (at best) before power was restored thoughout the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan area, Illustrious Sir reluctantly made the decision to cancel the August meeting as we did not know if we would have power that evening (it was actually restored mid-day Wednesday) and he knew that many of the local Nobles would be involved in cleanup at their homes. Hopefully our September Stated, in Waverly, will be the charm!

2020 dues are now past due. Dues are how we operate. We do not use Transportation Fund money to operate our Temple but we use Temple resources to help the Transportation of our kids. Check your dues card and if you do not have a 2020 sticker you may owe dues. Shriners International eMailed out dues notices in August and will soon be mailing dues notices to those who do not have eMail (or didn't pay from the eMail notice). (2021 dues should be paid for by December 31, 2020). If that notice comes and the amount owed is doubled, it means you forgot to pay your 2020 dues.
