cases in the State, the activities will be greatly reduced. Illustrious Sir Roberge cancelled the Second Section, Ladies Luncheon, and evening dinner. The meetings will be limited to 15 Nobles (including a moderator) and Nobles will not be able to participate in the meeting location if they have not notified the temple in advance.
