

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Potentate's Appointments Terminate When Illustrious Sir's Term Ends

When a Potentate's term of office expires, all appointments made by him during his administration terminate. Such appointments include: Potentate's Aides, Ambassadors, Unit Heads, Committee Chairmen and any other appointed officers.

Under Imperial Shrine Law, the Potentate of El Kahir Temple, when he is installed as Chief Executive Officer, must make his own appointments, including the six officers of the appointed Divan - First and Second Ceremonial Masters, Ceremonial Director, Marshall, Captain of the Guard and Outer Guard.

The El Kahir Temple Potentate has the power and authority to replace every appointee - or he may, if he believes it to be in the best interest of the El Kahir Temple, retain all appointees. Traditionally, for the sake of efficiency, many El Kahir Temple Nobles of demonstrated ability are continued in office by reappointment. But this is at the will and pleasure of the Potentate - Elect.

Courtesy requires that a Noble of El Kahir Temple holding an appointive office, position or assignment tender his resignation to the Potentate - Elect. If the Potentate - Elect desires an El Kahir Temple Noble to continue in his office by reappointment, he will be notified by the Potentate - Elect to that effect.

In addition to the Appointed Divan Officers, this applies to Ambassadors, Potentate's Aides, Committee Chairmen, Unit Heads; it does not apply to Shrine Club Officers. They are elected and installed by their membership before the Potentate - Elects take office.

If an El Kahir Temple Noble is not appointed for the ensuing year, he should deliver the official Temple Fez carrying any Title, Committee or Staff designation to the Temple Recorder, unless he is allowed by the Potentate - Elect to keep the official Fez for sentimental reasons. If this Fez is to be worn, however; all lettering except the name of El Kahir Temple should be removed. Any El Kahir Temple Noble not appointed to a position by the Potentate - Elect cannot wear a Fez carrying a Title or other designation; to do so is in violation of the Imperial Code.

The El Kahir Karavan Needs Your Support

Every month the Temple sends out approximately 450 issues. Of these, we send out 125 copies to the widows of Nobles. At a monthly cost of approximately \$0.60/ issue, keeping our widows informed of what is going on at El Kahir costs \$900 per year. We are asking that you consider donating at least \$35 per year for our Dime-A-Day (DAD) program to help fund the Karavan for these fine ladies. If only 26 Nobles subscribe for a dime-a-day, then the osts for keeping our widows informed is covered. Your name will appear in our monthly El Kahir Karavan and you will be assisting the Temple in continuing our publications
