# Official Call for the December Annual Election Stated Meeting Wednesday, December 14, 2022

# § 325.11 Election Regulations.

- (a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a résumé consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

# **Shriners Hospital Twin Cities Report**

Shriners Children's-Twin Cities Board of Governors held its annual fall retreat September 8 - 10. Thursday we got down to business with an initial discussion session that was scheduled to run from 7:30 to 8:45ish. We finally wrapped up our discussion session at 10:05 pm. That's what happens when you have a group of passionate Shriners gathered talking about how best to serve our Shrine Kids and their families.

Friday morning, we kicked off the retreat with a Microsoft TEAMS presentation from our Chairman of Shriners Children's, Imperial Sir Jerry Gantt who updated us on the status of our Shriners Children's healthcare system. Other presentations during the day included Melissa Forrest-Ancillary Services Manager, Audrey Haugen-Child Life, Jeff Bruce-POPS Coordinator, Scott Laubisch-SHC VP of Business Planning, Laurie Speiler-SHC VP of Legal Affairs, and Mel Bower-SCH Chief Communications Officer. All the presentations were very informative and afforded the members of the Board of Governors the opportunity to ask questions of our executive leadership in Tampa.

The resounding theme of the comments from Tampa is that what we are doing at the Twin Cities is the example that Shriners Children's is working to implement across our SHC Healthcare system, treating more kids in more places all while lowering our draw on the endowment as part of our Vision 2035 project.

We are short-staffed of physicians at the Twin Cities with the departure of Dr. Priola and the transition of our medical director, Dr. Lael Luedtke, to our Shriners Children's Springfield. We are fortunate to have Dr. Luedtke make her transition to Springfield from the Twin Cities spread out over the next couple of months. Our Administrator, David Voller, is in high gear recruitment mode looking for new physicians to fill our openings at both the Twin Cities and at Blank Children's UnityPoint in Des Moines.

One of the best things to happen is that now we have received the approval for community direct referrals to Shriners Children's Twin Cities from physicians outside Shriners for Therapy. This is a great opportunity for us to add new patients and serve more kids. We are anxiously awaiting to also receive approval to accept direct referrals for POPS and Imaging. I'll keep you posted as the process moves forward... wish us luck!

Our Business Development Team is working on building relationships and partnerships across our Twin Cities catchment area in Nebraska, South Dakota, Minnesota, and Wisconsin.

The Board of Governors approved our Strategic Plan and Budget for 2023 that will be sent to the Joint Boards in Tampa.

At our Twin Cities BOG meeting it was discussed that some of the Van Drivers had expressed their desire for TV and a few creature comforts in the Driver's Lounge. Since that expense is not in our budget, it was suggested that the Temples in our catchment area be asked to make an annual donation to the Driver Lounge Fund to support the cost of

TV, furniture, snacks, etc. A \$100.00 annual commitment to the Driver Lounge Fund was suggested.

Also, be on the lookout for Kids that can use the pediatric orthopedic services that we provide at our Shriners Children's Twin Cities. Thank you for all you do for our beloved fraternity and philanthropy. "You are an Ambassador of the World's Greatest Philanthropy!"
