2023 Membership Phase II Grand Raffle

Brother Nobles,

I am writing to let you know of a NEW program developed to help to engage OUR Nobility and bring more Nobles into El Kahir Shrine. Throughout 2022, **Membership Phase I, Temple General Marketing,** has been incredibly successful raising the attendance at our monthly events: Director's Staff Basket Night (2nd Friday of the month), Bingo (Every Thursday evening) and Revvin Fezzes' Omelet Breakfast (1st Sunday of the month). Our Kids' Day with an attendance of 250 kids and their parents has also benefited from our Marketing Investment.

To be honest, though, we have not substantially brought more Nobles back into El Kahir Shrine. I am announcing **Membership Phase II, Noble Engagement**. This program has been developed to incentivize our Nobility to engage their Blue Lodge Master Masons to become a El Kahir Nobles. Additionally, our Nobility can engage with their friends, coworkers and family to join a Blue Lodge then to become a Noble of the Shrine. In order to qualify, you must be current with your 2023 El Kahir dues. There will be a drawing @ OUR December '23 El Kahir Stated Meeting (12-13-23) for a Grand Prize of \$500!

In order to get an entry into the drawing, just do one or more of the below options **AND BE THEIR TOP LINE SIGNER**:

This includes installing sensory space equipment in Rehab Therapy, being approved for direct community referrals for rehab, developing cranial facial offerings for plagiocephaly and torticollis along with gaining approval of our 2023 strategic plan, budget and specific initiatives to develop further affiliated partnerships.

The El Kahir Karavan Needs Your Support

Every month the Temple sends out approximately 450 issues. Of these, we send out 125 copies to the widows of Nobles. At a monthly cost of approximately \$0.60/ issue, keeping our widows informed of what is going on at El Kahir costs \$900 per year. We are asking that you consider donating at least \$35 per year for our Dime-A-Day (DAD) program to help fund the Karavan for these fine ladies. If only 26 Nobles subscribe for a dime-a-day, then the costs for keeping our widows informed is covered.
